1. When was the inception of the School?

- In 2006

2. Which is the entry level in your school?

- Entry level for NCFE starts from Playgroup

3. What are the age criteria for applying in NCFE?

- Class 1 – 5 Years 5 Months as on 1st June (AGE MATRIX)

4. Are there any entrance exams for admission?

- There will be informal interactions till Class 2
- Objective test papers from Grade 3 to 8
- Written exams for Grade 9 and above.

5. What is the total strength per class?

- 30 - 35 students per class
- For all the Primary classes we will have 2 teachers in the classroom.

6. What is the total strength of the school?

- The total strength of the school from Class I – Class XII is 2700 plus

7. Till what classes do you have?

- We have classes up to XII

8. What are the extra-curricular activities offered?

10. What is the qualification of teachers in NCFE?

- All teachers are Post Graduates.
- More than 90% of the teachers have done their B. Ed and the rest of them are pursuing B. Ed (as mandated by CBSE)

11. What are the second languages offered and from which class?

- Class II – Class X Std - Hindi, Kannada, French & Sanskrit
- Class I follow a 2 Language system, (Karnataka regulation) where parents can choose one language which they prefer.

12. What are the III Languages offered and from which class?

- The III languages offered are Hindi, Sanskrit, French & Kannada
- The III languages are applicable from V Std to VIII std. No changes of language will be permitted
- **Kannada is a mandated language (second due to Karnataka regulation)**

13. What are the Medical facilities available to students?

- We have a trained nurse, Medical Room and basic first aid facilities on campus
- We have a tie up with the nearby hospital for other emergencies

14. How many batches passed out of Class X and XII?

- Class X – 8 Batches
- Class XII – 6 Batches

15. How is NCFE Alumni results?

- In the previous academic year, we had 17 centum
- 30% of the students scoring above 90%, and more than 60 % students scoring above 80%.
- We have achieved 100% results since our maiden Class 10 examination

16. Which subject combinations do we offer in XI & XII?

- **Which Text Books do you use?**

- We follow various publications and from Class 6 onwards we will be only using NCERT books next year.
- Key Talking points
 - More content in Publications than NCERT
 - Tough to get NCERT books and will be delayed.
 - We don't follow ICSE books
 - Extra topics will be covered via clubs, assignments and other activities

20. What is the procedure for seeking admission in Class X?

- Admission to class X in a school is open to:-
 - a student who has passed class IX
 - is migrating from/ within one city/ state to another only on the transfer of the parent(s) or shifting of his/her family from one place to another
Application has to be forwarded by the new school to Regional Office concerned together with details and certified copies of the following documents, within one month of admission of the student for obtaining post fact to approval of the Board:
 - a. Progress report card of the previous class.
 - b. Transfer / school Leaving Certificate duly countersigned by the Educational Authorities in respect of State / other than CBSE.
 - c. Transfer/Movement Order of the parent (s) in respect of transfer or proof of new residence in respect of the shifting of family from one place to another.

21. What is the percentage of attendance required to appear in the Secondary / Senior Secondary Examination?

- At least 75% attendance in an academic session is required to be eligible to appear for the classes IX, X, XI and XII examination
- Candidates taking up a subject (s) involving practical examination are also required to possess at least 75% of the total attendance for practical work in the subject in the laboratory. In respect of students participating in Sports at National level organized by recognized Federations / CBSE / School Games Federation of India (SGFI), the required percentage of attendance is 60%. Such candidates taking up a subject (s) involving practical examination are also required to possess 60% of the total attendance for practical work in the subject in the laboratory
- According to rule 14 of Examination Bye-laws Shortage up to 15% only can be condoned by the Chairperson in respect of those students appearing for the Secondary Examinations conducted by the Board and Senior School Certificate Examination. Cases of candidates with attendance below 60% in class X or class XII, appearing for the Board's examinations, as the case may be, shall be considered for condonation of shortage of attendance by the Chairperson only in exceptional circumstances created on medical grounds, such as candidate suffering from serious diseases like cancer, AIDS, TB or similar serious diseases requiring long
